## **JESSEL ROSEN RESEARCH AWARD – RULES FOR AWARD**

1. The Jessel Rosen Research Award will be made to an undergraduate student of the Electrical (& Electronic) Engineering Department of the Faculty of Engineering, for a research topic which is preferably of the student's own choice and specification. Candidates, of either sex, should be in the penultimate or earlier year of their course. The research project should be of not less than six weeks duration, undertaken during the summer vacation and normally carried out in college. The topic for the project will not be restricted, but should if possible be related to power generation, high voltage transmission, or ship propulsion.
2. Candidates may be of any nationality and either sex, but must be domiciled in the United Kingdom. The value of the award will be in line with an OC Trust UROP Bursary, currently £600.
3. The award carries with it Life Membership of the City & Guilds College Association (formerly the Old Centralians' Association), funded from the income of the Jessel Rosen Trust.
4. In the event of there being more than one eminently suitable candidate, the final nomination should be the result of consultations within the Department made by the Senior Tutor, and should be ratified by the Head of Department and the Dean of Engineering before being passed to the Honorary Secretary of the Old Centralians Trust. Where necessary the Trust may request that the Chairman of the Trust Board (or his nominee) should interview applicants.
5. Following completion of the research assignment supported by the award, a report of the work shall be sent to the Head of Department and to the Old Centralians' Trust Fund Board, who will consider the suitability and/or desirability of publication in the "Imperial Engineer" journal, circulated to all Alumni who are members of the City & Guilds College Association (and of the Royal School of Mines Association).
6. Application should be made in writing on the standard Old Centralians' Trust Application Form, obtainable on request from Dr Teresa Sergot, Level 2, Faculty Building, Imperial College, LONDON, SW7 2AZ (Tel. 41184). Applications should be accompanied by full details of the research proposals and anticipated budget. Completed applications, together with written confirmation of support by the Head of Department and the Dean of Engineering, should be forwarded to the Honorary Secretary of the Trust Fund Board at the address below.
7. The award will normally be made annually, unless a successful application for the Rosen Award for Graduate Overseas Experience in a Third World Country has taken precedence.
