JESSEL ROSEN TRAVEL AWARD – RULES FOR AWARD

1. The Jessel Rosen Travel Award will be made to an undergraduate student of the Electrical & Electronic Engineering Department of the Faculty of Engineering, for a period of "Overseas Professional Experience", normally undertaken during the Summer Vacation. Candidates, of either sex, should be in the penultimate or earlier year of their course.
2. A Departmental Committee, convened by the Senior Tutor, and including the Head and Deputy Head of the Electrical Engineering Department, will select a suitable student and make a recommendation to the Old Centralians' Trust Fund Board. The recommendation should ideally be forwarded to the Honorary Secretary of the Old Centralians' Trust before the end of May in the Year of award, and should be supported by the Dean of Engineering.
3. The award is currently (2006) valued at £500, although its value may be increased, in appropriate circumstances, at the discretion of the Trust Fund Board.
4. The Chairman of the Trust Fund Board (or his Deputy) will attend college on an appropriate day, meet with the nominee, explain the origin of the award, present a cheque, and take lunch at the College with the winner and members of the departmental committee. The departmental committee will provide a suitable photograph of the recipient for retention in the Trust Board records.
5. The recipient of the Award will be expected to submit to the Trust Board a report of his or her experience, which may at the discretion of the Board be considered for inclusion in the "Imperial Engineer" Journal of the City & Guilds College Association and the Royal School of Mines Association.
6. If no award is made in any particular year, the Trust Board may, at its discretion, make two awards in a subsequent year, or a single award at an increased value.
7. Without imposing any absolute rule, it will be regarded as desirable that wherever possible the Jessel Rosen Travel Award and the Jessel Rosen Research Award should be made to students of opposite sex.
8. Successful applicants, if not already members of the City & Guilds College Association, will be strongly encouraged to take up membership.
9. The recipient also receives an invitation to attend the Annual Dinner of the City & Guilds College Association.
