**Cutlers' Hall, Wednesday 29 February 2012**

The 99th Annual Dinner of the Association will be held at Cutlers' Hall, Warwick Lane, London EC4M 7BR, in the City of London. The Cutlers' Company received its first Royal Charter from Henry V in 1416. Since that time there have been five Halls, one of which was completely destroyed in the Great Fire of London in 1666. The current Hall was opened in 1888.

**Sir William Wakeham**

**former Vice Chancellor of University of Southampton**

Sir William (Bill) Wakeham retired as a Vice Chancellor of Southampton University in 2009, having taken this position in 2001. From 1971 to 2001 he was in the Department of Chemical Engineering and Chemical Technology at Imperial College, where he progressed from a Lecturer to Professor and Head of Department of Chemical Engineering, before becoming Pro-Rector (Research) and subsequently also Deputy Rector and Pro-Rector (Resources). He is a Fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering, the Institution of Chemical Engineers, the Institution of Engineering and Technology, and the Institute of Physics. His other roles have included membership of the board of the South East England Development Agency (SEEDA); chair of the Universities and Colleges Employers Association (UCEA); membership of the EPSRC Council and chairing its Resources Audit Committee. At the request of the then Secretary of State for Innovation, Universities and Skills he chaired the 2008 review of Physics in the UK and in 2009 he chaired the Study by RAEng of Engineering Graduates for Industry. In May 2011 he was appointed as the President of the Institution of Chemical Engineers (IChemE) and is Senior Vice President and Honorary International Secretary of the Royal Academy of Engineering. He was knighted in the Queen's Birthday honours in 2009 for services to Chemical Engineering and Higher Education.
